



R. Michael Buckley, MD, FACP, FIDSA
Chief Executive of Pennsylvania Hospital (retired)

Dr. Buckley received his BA and MD from Yale University where he was an All-American swimmer and member of the US National Team in 1967. He trained in Internal Medicine at The University of North Carolina in Chapel Hill. After completing his Infectious Disease fellowship at The University of Pennsylvania he joined the staff of The Pennsylvania Hospital.

Dr. Buckley held a number of leadership positions over his 38 years at the hospital including Chief of the Infectious Disease Section, Chairman of the Department of Medicine, Chief Medical Officer, and Chief Executive Officer. He retired as CEO in 2014.

Dr. Buckley was a member of both The Clinical Affairs Committee, and of The Board of Directors of the Infectious Diseases Society of America. In addition to the Board of PYSC , he is a member of the Board of Waverly Heights, a continuing care retirement community, where he also serves as Chair of their Health and Wellness committee.
